



FOSTER PARENTING

Children are placed in foster care when their own families are unable to provide a safe and secure home. Most have been removed by DHS due to physical abuse, neglect, sexual abuse or other serious family problems. Foster care is a last resort when every effort to keep a family together has failed. Foster Care is a temporary situation until the family is able to address the issues and the child can be returned home or be placed in an adoptive home.

Therapeutic Foster Care provides a network of family homes for children ages 3 through 18 who need a safe environment to live in due to a family crisis. Within this network of homes children are given counseling and family life experiences that will allow them to develop emotionally, socially, academically and take steps in the healing process.
